

SNOEZELEN

INTERVENTION DESCRIPTION FOR THE SUPPORT OF PEOPLE WITH PROFOUND INTELLECTUAL AND MULTIPLE DISABILITIES (PIMD)

PhD project

We are developing an intervention description snoezelen to enable support persons of people with PIMD to use snoezelen in a purposeful and effective manner. We shaped the intervention description as a user-friendly tool for support persons to adapt snoezelen to the needs of the person with PIMD.

STEP 2: SURVEY STUDY



To describe the use and effectiveness of snoezelen in people with PIMD from the perspective of support persons by conducting a survey study.

STEP 1: LITERATURE REVIEW



To describe the use and effectiveness of snoezelen in people with intellectual disabilities and dementia through a systematic review of scientific literature.

STEP 3: DESIGN RESEARCH

Development of an e-instruction and digital formats to make an individual snoezelen plan and chart. Support persons provided feedback on prototypes and observations were used to evaluate the use of snoezelen and the intervention description.

STEP 4: EFFECT STUDIES

To evaluate the effect of snoezelen on the person with PIMD and the support person using our intervention description. Results expected in 2025.
